几十年里的有关儿童(逆境中)回弹力的研究中最具有共同性的结论就是:能适应困境挫折的儿童在成长过程中至少有过一个稳定可靠的人际关系(家长,老师,或其他)。

... the <u>single most common finding</u> is that children who end up doing well have had <u>at least one stable and committed</u> <u>relationship</u> with a supportive parent, caregiver, or other adult.






